Changing Your Password

You have several options to choose from:

- **Remittance Reporting:**
 - **Create New Remittance:** Choose this option if you would like to create a new remittance report to send to the Fund Office.
 - **Upload New Remittance:** Choose this option if you would like to upload you payroll export configured to the specifications in this guide (see page 39 for details on the Upload template) to submit to the fund office.
 - **Submit a 'No Work' Report:** Choose this option if you would like to submit a “no hours” remittance to the fund office
 - **Continue an Unfiled Report:** Choose this option if you have previously started a remittance and saved it to finish later.

- **View Report History:** Choose this option if you would like to view a listing of all previously filed and archived reports, which are viewable as PDF documents.

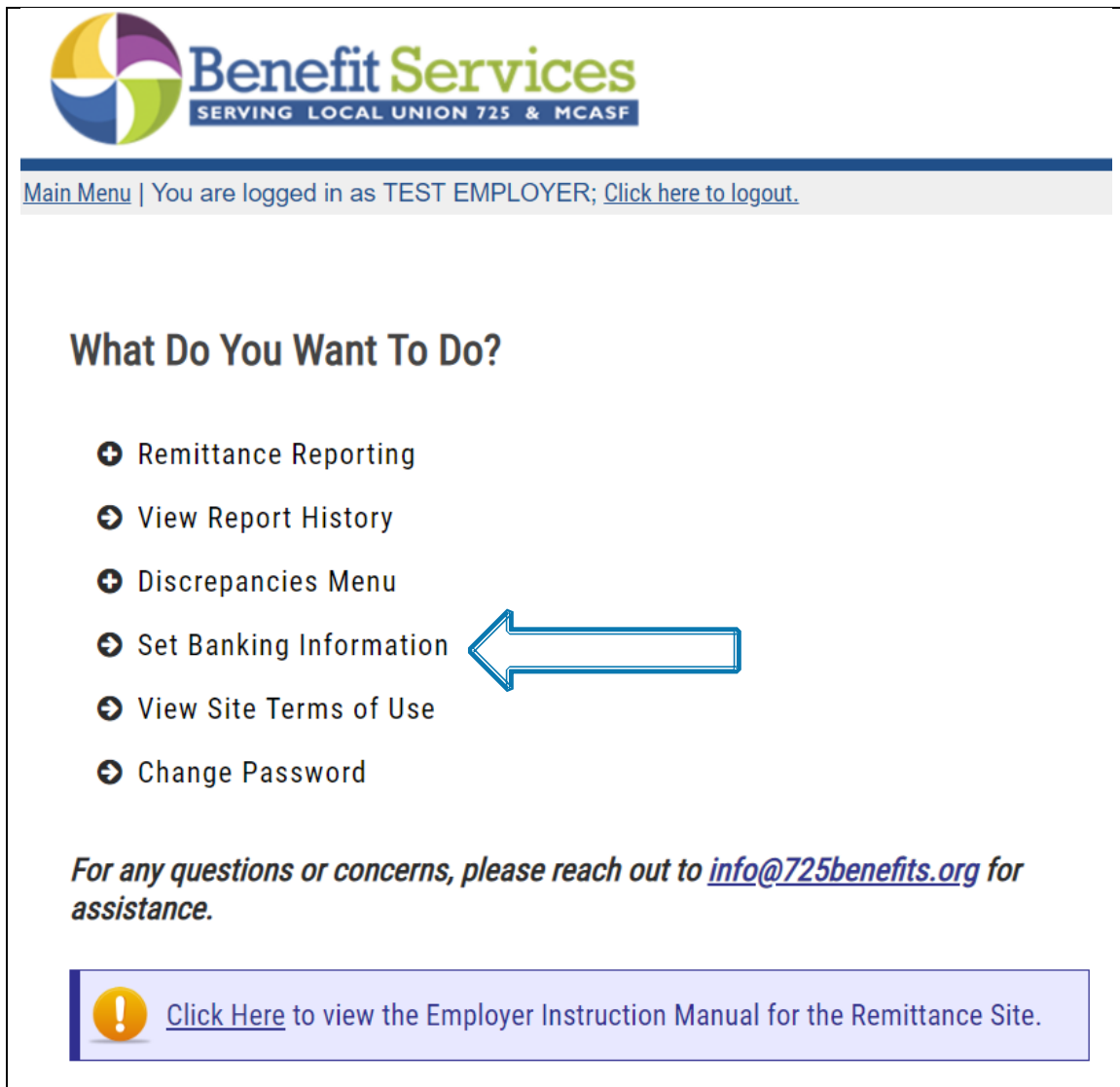
- **Discrepancies Menu:**
 - **View Discrepancies:** Choose this option to view all outstanding balances
 - **View/Pay Discrepancies:** Choose this option to make payments on any outstanding balances
 - **View Paid Discrepancies:** Choose this option to view all outstanding balances that you have paid on through I-Remit.

- **Set Banking Information:** Choose this option to enter in banking information to be eligible for ACH payments.

- **Change Password:** Choose this option to change your login password.

Set Banking Information

The website's *Set Banking Information* option provides employers with the opportunity to enroll in ACH payment processing. Choose the *Set Banking Information* from the *Main Menu* for this option.

Please note: Your banking information must be set up before ACH payment processing is in effect. If you create any remittances prior to setting up your banking information, it will not go through as an ACH payment and you will need to contact the Fund Office or mail in your check.

Once *Set Banking Information* has been selected from the *Main Menu*, you will be taken to the *Update Banking Information* screen:

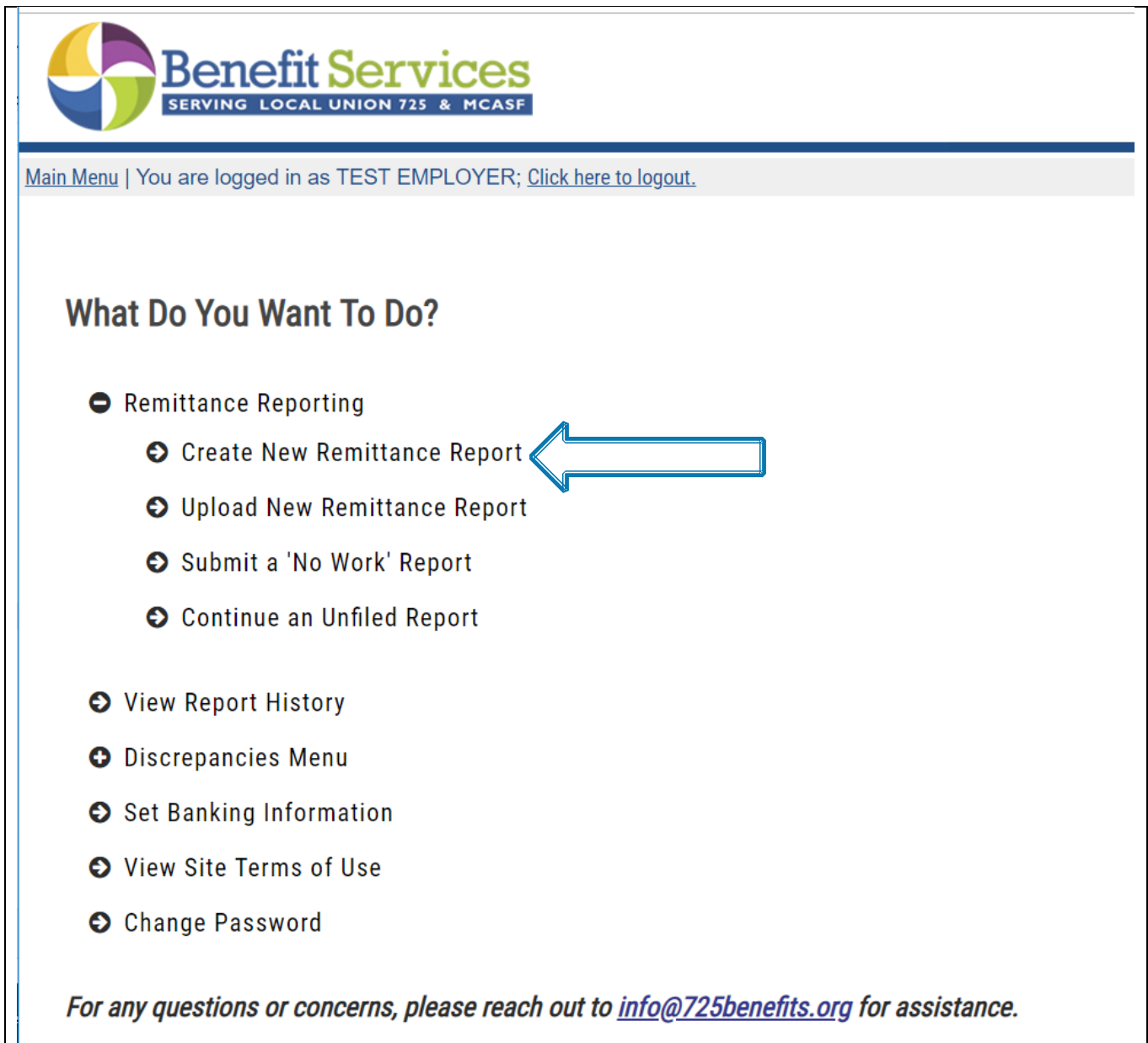

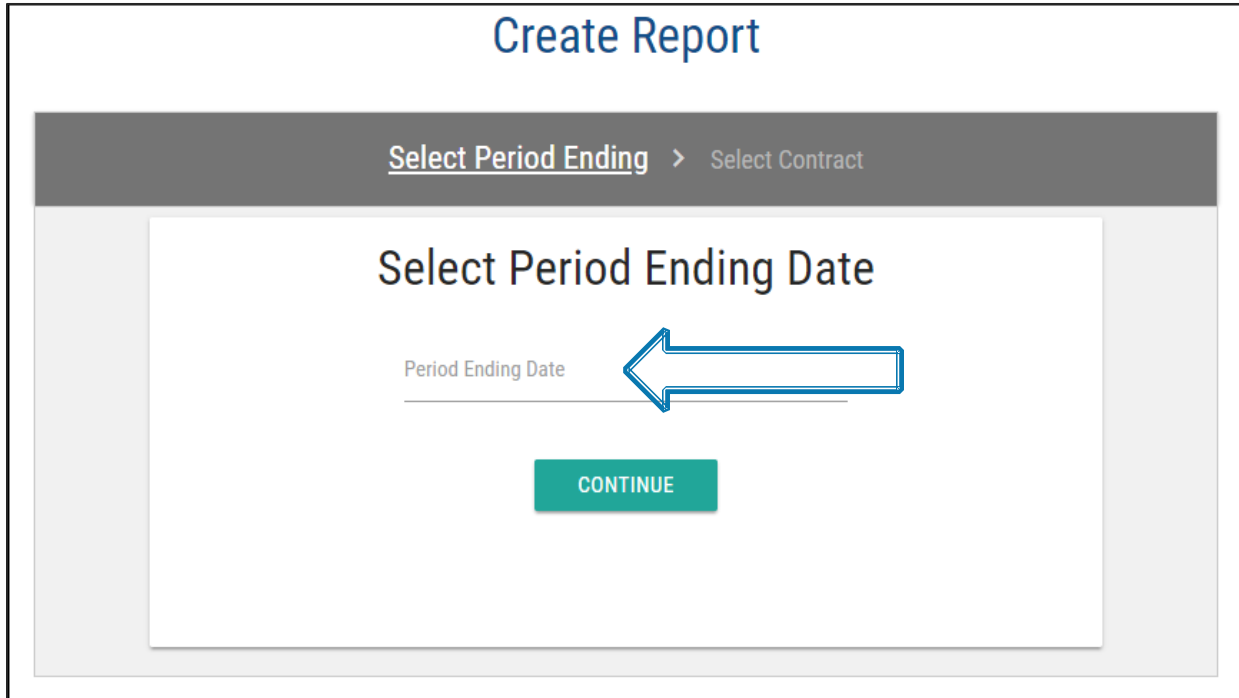
Creating a New Remittance Report

To create a new remittance report, choose the *Remittance Reporting* option, and choose *Create New Remittance Report* on the *Main Menu*.

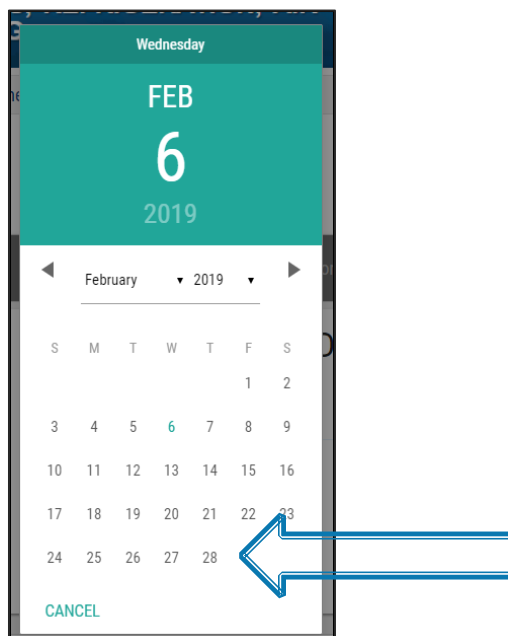

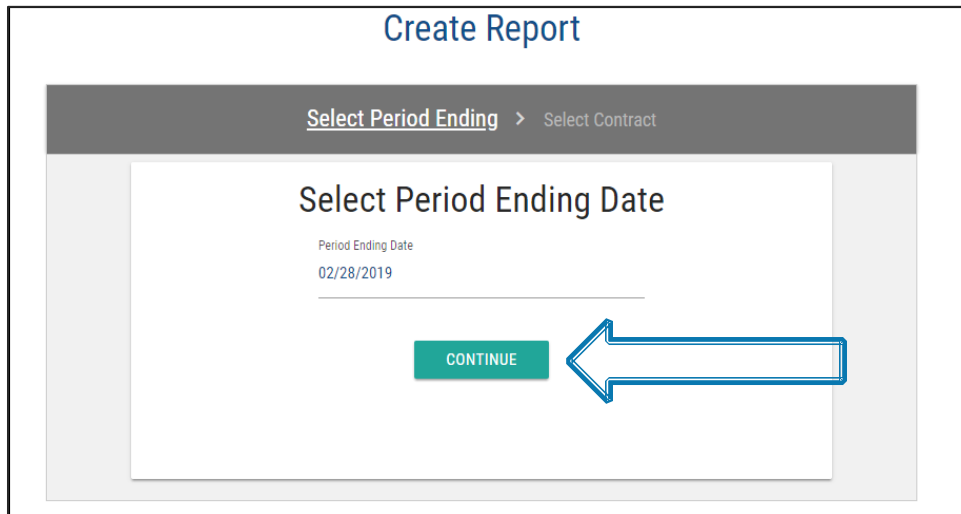
You will then be prompted to select the period ending date. Click the *Period Ending Date*, right above the line to bring up the monthly calendar.



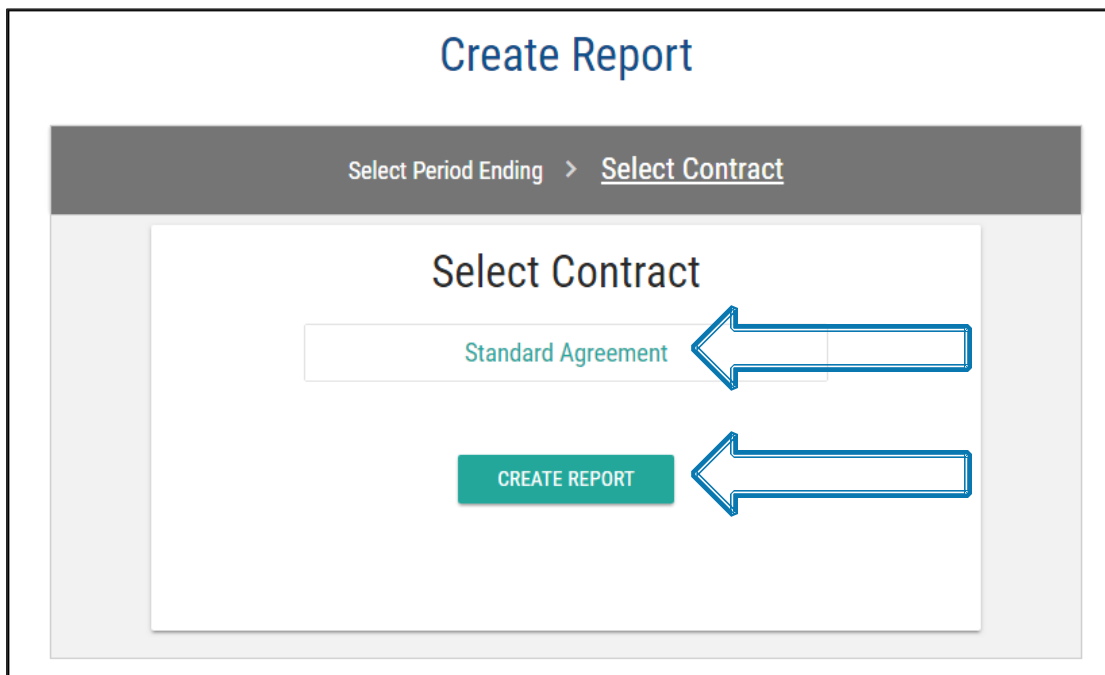
Choose the final date in the period you are reporting for. In the below example if you are reporting for the month of February you would choose the 28th.



After you have selected the *Period Ending Date*. Click *Continue*.



Next, you will be asked to *Select Contract* for the contract you are reporting for. Choose the contract and click the *CREATE REPORT* button.



Please Note: You may see more or fewer contracts than those listed above depending on your specific reporting needs. If you believe you need to report for a contract that you do not see listed under your login, please contact the Fund Office.

Uploading a Remittance Report

If you would like to have the functionality to upload your payroll file into the website, you must comply with the “Upload File Specifications” section of this instruction manual on Pg. 46.

Once your file is properly formatted and meets the specifications of the site, you will be able to upload it to the remittance processing site. For regular remittance reports, please select the option “Upload a New Remittance Report” to continue.

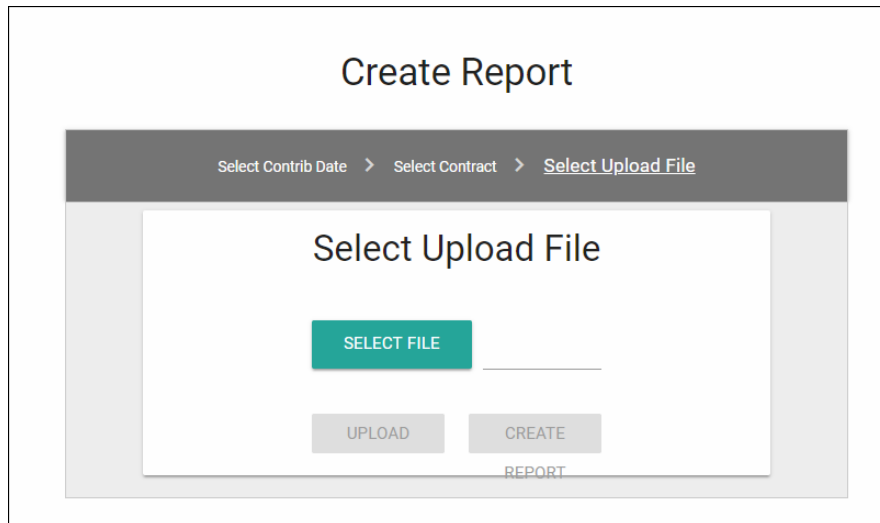

After clicking “Upload New Remittance Report”, you will be directed to the “Select Period Ending Date” screen to select the work period of the report and then the “Select Contract” screen to select the contract you are reporting. Once you have selected the date and contract you are reporting, you will be brought to the “Select Upload File” screen. Please click on the *Browse* button to find the .csv or .txt file stored on your PC. After double clicking on the appropriate file, please click on the *Upload* button.

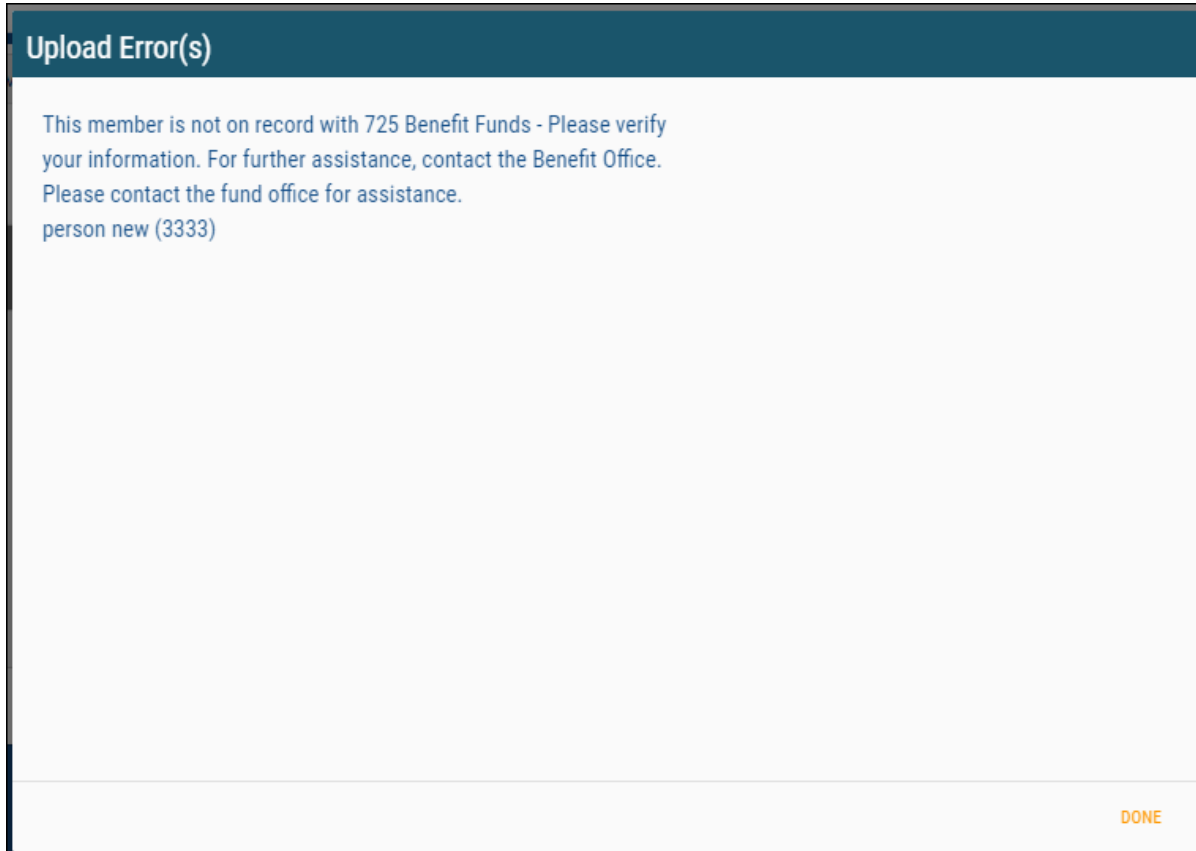


Once you choose the “Upload” option, the system automatically checks each SSN provided in the file. If there is a participant on the upload who is not on file with the fund office, the upload will fail, and you will receive a warning message to contact the fund office.

If your file is rejected, please refer to the “Rejected Upload File” section below for more information regarding fixing these rejected members. If the file is accepted, you will automatically be taken to the Remittance Entry screen. Please then refer to the “Accepted Upload File” section beginning on the next page.

Rejected Upload File

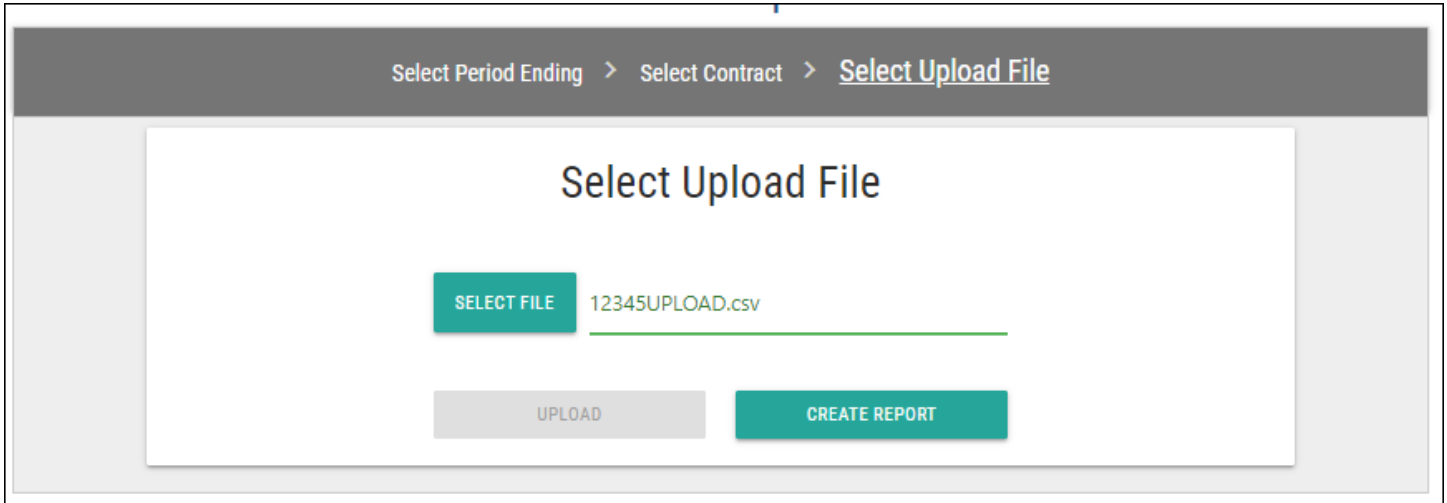
If there are participants that are not stored in the fund's database on your file. The system will then display an error list containing the full name on the file and in parenthesis the last four digits of their SSN. Please follow the directions displayed in the error message prior to uploading your file again



Once you have verified any new member SSNs with the Fund Office, you should then re-upload your file. You may then re-load your file by clicking the Done button in the bottom left of the error screen then selecting the new file.

Accepted Upload File

If the upload file is accepted, after clicking on the *Upload* button, click on the Create Report button.



You will then be directed to the “Enter remittance report” screen. The remittance entry table will now be populated based off of the data in your upload file.

The remittance page will display all uploaded member data. You may then edit or add data into the remittance entry table if needed. Then submit the report.

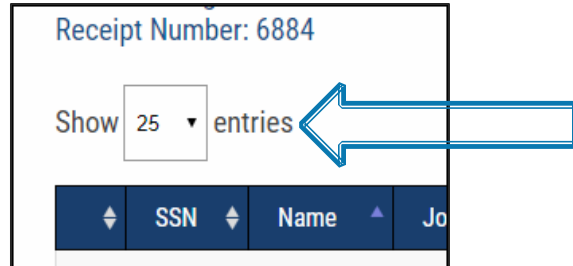

If you did not upload the file, participants from your last reported work month will pre-populate with the Name, SSN, and Job Class pre-filled. You will enter the Wages, Standard Hours, Overtime Hours, and Double Time Hours. The Hours Worked and Hours Paid will calculate automatically.

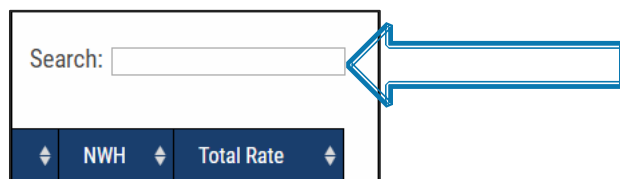

Remittance Entry Table Functionality

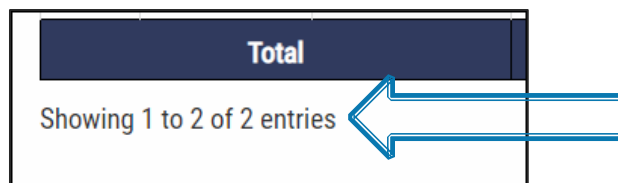
In the upper left-hand corner above the table, the *Show # entries* option controls the number of participants you see listed on the page. Display as few as 10 and up to 100 per page:



Above the table is a search box that filters based on name.



In the lower left-hand corner below the remittance entry table, the table lists how many participants are displaying on the page out of how many participants are on the report.



Underneath the remittance entry table, there is a list indicating the number of pages available within the report. To display the next page of participants, you can either select the next number in the series or hit the *Next* button (if there is more than one page listed). You may also go to the specific page by clicking on the specific page number (if applicable).



The remittance table features a row on the bottom of the table that calculates a running total for the hours and wages.

Total Rate Column/Participant Contribution Pop up

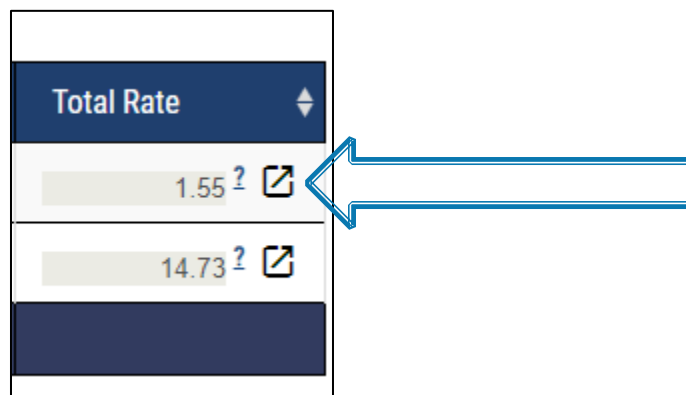
The Total Rate column has two features in it – it provides the total hourly rate summing the rates billed against the members hours, with a hover-over feature that provides the break down of the funds and their rates for the classification the member is being reported under. To trigger the hover over, you can simply slide the mouse over the question mark in the field:

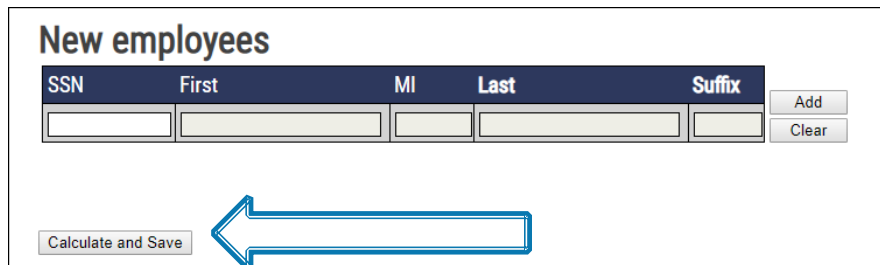

Using Calculate & Save to Complete a Report

After all relevant information has been entered into the remittance entry table, please click on the *Calculate and Save* button below the *New employees* section.

Calculate and Save

At any point, you may click on the *Calculate and Save* button if you have started entering a remittance and are unable to finish it during your website session. The website will then not only calculate the fund contribution totals, but also save your report so that you have the option of completing it later. If you decide that you would like to complete the remittance report later, click on the *Calculate and Save* button. Then, you may click on the *Main Menu* link on the top left side of the page, or you can logout by clicking on the [Click here to logout.](#) link.



If you decide that you would like to complete the report later, you may select the *Continue an Unfiled Report* option to finish your remittance report. Please see Pg. 33 for more information on completing an unfiled report.

Calculating the Remittance Report

In addition to saving your remittance report, clicking on the *Calculate and Save* button will also calculate the fund contribution totals. The table will summarize the *Total Wages*, *Total Hours Worked*, *Total Hours Paid* and *Total Owed* per fund.

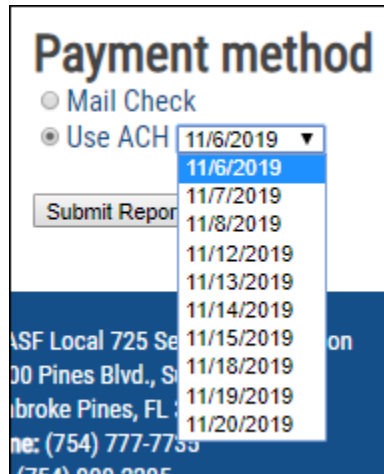

Underneath the *Comments* section you will the *Payment Method* option. If you have entered your banking information into ISSi-Remit (see Pg. 7 for instructions on how to set your banking information) you will see the option to *Mail Check* or *Use ACH*.

If you choose to *Mail Check* you will simply print the PDF sheet of your ISSi-Remit submission (see Pg. 21 for instructions on accessing your PDF remittance sheet) and mail it, along with your check, to the Fund Office.

If you choose the *Use ACH* option, you will see a dropdown menu to the right of the word ACH that shows you the date that the money will clear and be deducted from your bank account. This date will always be at least 2 business days from the day that you are entering your remittance, unless it is a holiday because the bank will not accept ACH payments on holidays. You have the option of choosing any business day within the next 10 days, that is at least 2 business days out.



Submitting the Report

After you have reviewed the fund contribution totals, please click the *Submit Report* button to send the report to the Fund Office. You will then be directed to a screen confirming that your report has been submitted to the Fund Office. The confirmation page will display your receipt number for the remittance report (located directly below your address).

View Paid Discrepancies

If you are enrolled as an ACH employer, you can view paid discrepancies. Select the “Discrepancies Menu” option and click on “View Paid Discrepancies” to proceed.

On the “View Your Paid Discrepancies” screen, a table of all paid outstanding balances will display. Every discrepancy listed has either been paid or is a pending payment. Upload File Specifications

File Formats

- The upload file must be in a Comma-Separated Values or Text format. This means .csv and .txt are the only file format extension the site can accept.
- Files with an extension of .pdf or .xls / .xlsx cannot be accepted. If your payroll software is only capable of importing data into a Microsoft Excel file (.xls or .xlsx), then you will need to open the document in Microsoft Excel and then resave the file in a .csv format prior to uploading the file.
- The file does not require a header row.

Fields

- We do not require any leading or trailing zeros for any field.
- If any field contains a comma, dollar sign, or quotation marks, then you must include quotation marks around the entire field. If you prefer, you can include quotation marks around every field in the file.
